**RGL Holdings announces new focus, strengthened management team**

*Combination of Leicht Transfer & Storage Co. and Checker Logistics  
creates full-service logistics organization*

GREEN BAY, Wis. -- (Aug. 27, 2002) -- For shippers in the Upper Midwest, a single phone call to companies owned by RGL Holdings will provide access to a full range of logistics services, from transporting and warehousing goods to managing an entire supply chain.

Formed by the combination of Leicht Transfer & Storage Co. and Checker Logistics in April 2001, RGL Holdings has beefed up its ability to provide integrated distribution services with the goal of becoming a larger player in the Midwest. The company has made investments in technology, added supply chain expertise, and expanded its management team since its formation.

The combined company now offers a wide variety of supply chain management services including warehousing, distribution center management and order fulfillment, trucking, Intermodal, cross-dock, port services and supply chain consulting. Leicht and Checker currently serve more than 300 customers ranging from Fortune 500 to small businesses. The company provides services for the paper (raw material and finished goods), packaging, food, bulk commodities, heavy machinery, plastics, and chemical industries.

"Our goal is to provide a simple, best value solution for supply chain management needs," said RGL Holding President and CEO Bob Johnson, a 20-year transportation industry veteran who joined the company in Sept. 2001. "Our 'one stop shipping' strategy has been positively received by our customers."

Leicht and Checker have more than 3 million square feet of warehouse space, 85 tractors, 150 trailers (bulk, van, flatbeds, chasis), an Intermodel yard with 70,000-pound lift capability, and two marine docks (ports). Customers can achieve cost savings and service improvements through Leicht & Checker's pricing of bundled services; reduced internal administrative cost with "one-stop shipping;" a variety of warehouse types to meet a customer's service and storage requirements; innovative and efficient material handling equipment and processes; visibility of inventory; and supply chain analysis.

Johnson has extensive experience in van truckload, dry bulk truckload and warehouse distribution, including serving as president of two truckload carriers, Road Runner Distribution and Transport Corporation of America, and a distribution and dry bulk company, Trans Plastics, Inc.

Prior to joining RGL Holdings, Thiem was the director of transportation for Shopko stores and has held numerous positions with Schneider National, Inc., including Chief Accounting Officer and Vice President of Customer Service.
